

Youth Camp 16th-21st September

Practical information

When?

The youth camp takes place from Tuesday the 16th to Sunday the 21st of September. You can arrive a few days earlier and leave on the 22nd if you wish to take part to the preparation and/or cleaning up the camp. If so, please register on youthcampmalmo@collectifs.net

Where?

The youth camp is based in Holma's farm, in the village of Höör, in the North-East of Malmö.

How to take part to the camp?

We recommend you to register by sending an email to youthcampmalmo@collectifs.net and fill up the registration form.

Registration is not compulsory, but it will help a lot organizing the camp. We can not guaranty that if too many people come up at the camp at the last moment the camp can integrate everybody.

Participation to the camp is under your personal responsibility. For this reason, persons below 18 years old must be accompanied by an adult.

What is means to take part to the camp?

All participants are responsible of themselves, for others living in the camp and collectively for the camp.

- During your stay at the camp, you are expected to be always responsible for what you do, which means for example that alcohol is tolerated but with moderation.
- We promote solidarity and helping each other, respecting differences and emphasizing on the diversity. Racism, sexism and any other kind of discrimination will not be tolerated and will imply the expulsion from the camp.
- You are invited to take part to the logistic of the camp and propose activities. We consider activities directly linked to our livelihood in the camp as at least as important as the workshops and discussions that take place within the camp: cooking, managing toilets and sanitary, self-building etc... are fully part of the camp and all participants are expected to take part to it. An assembly will take place every evening to discuss the camp organization, the purpose of the camp, etc...

How to get there?

To Malmö:

- There are bus leaving from several European cities to Malmö for ESF. See esf2008.org. From Belgium, contact Fabrice Collignon <info@wsf.be>, from Berlin, contact martin.dahm@bundjugend.de;
- Some groups are getting organized to come by bike: from Berlin and from Brussels.
- Car sharing

From Malmö you can arrive to Holma:

- By foot, bicycles, horse,...
- By train: Trains run twice an hour to Höör except from 1:00 to 5:00 in the night. Holma is about 20 minutes walk from the station. Follow the camp signs.

What do you need to bring?

The followings are highly necessary:

- A tent or a place where you can sleep, sleeping bag and blankets. Nights can be very cold in Sweden at this time of the year!!!!
- A plate, a cup, fork, knife and spoon.
- Hot clothes

But we also recommend you to take:

- An electric torch
- A local food products from your region
- Music instruments
- Material for a workshop that you would like to propose
